EXPO attendees who fly in should plan to bring their own tie downs. Camping "under the wing" is allowed, but space is limited. Mt. Vernon Outland Airport has a nice camping area near its

> lakeshore shelters. On-site campers are encouraged to place their tents at the lakeshore camping area. Showers are limited.

but available and located inside the FBO building. which is a short walk from the camping area. There is no tie-down fee or charge for camping at the airport.

The Mt. Vernon Holiday Inn is the headquarters hotel for this event. A block of rooms is being held for attendees. Mention the Midwest LSA EXPO when making
